Literacy Tests Set For New Voters

The New York State Board of Regents has announced that a literacy test for new voters will be given in public schools from 9:30 A. M. to 10:30 P. M. on Oct. 11.

Accompanying the literacy test will be a test of the voter's ability to read and write. Such a voter, native or foreign born, is one who has not voted in the state since Jan. 1, 1952, but who has been qualified to vote in the state before that date.

Any person who qualifies for the vote before that date, regardless of whether that person has previously voted in the state, is not a "new voter" under the law.

Such a person need not show a diploma nor a certificate of literacy in order to vote.

Any person who is unable to read or write may be established as a "new voter" by the presentation of a certificate of graduation from an eight-year public school or a certificate of graduation from a high school.

(Continued from Page 1) The mosque did not disappear then. It broke up into several pieces.

To Kuba Khan went Calicut. To Batu went nearly all of what is now European Russia.
